Safeguarding means keeping you **safe from harm** — at school, at home, and online. Hans Price Academy is **committed to safeguarding** every student. You have the right to feel safe, respected, and listened to. If something feels wrong, **please always tell someone you trust.**



What is Harm?

- ✓ Physical harm — being hurt on purpose
- ✓ Emotional harm — being made to feel worthless
- ✓ Neglect — not getting basic food or care
- ✓ Sexual harm — unwanted touching or content
- ✓ Bullying — in person or online
- ✓ Exploitation — being used or groomed



Your Rights at HPA

- ✓ Feel safe at all times
- ✓ Be treated with respect
- ✓ Have your voice heard
- ✓ Say no to things that feel wrong
- ✓ Get help from a trusted adult
- ✓ Learn in a safe environment



Warning Signs

- ✓ Someone makes you feel scared or unsafe
- ✓ An adult asks you to keep secrets
- ✓ You're pressured to do something wrong
- ✓ You feel very sad or worried a lot
- ✓ Someone touches you without permission
- ✓ Something just feels "not right"



It Is NEVER Your Fault

- ✓ Abuse is ALWAYS the abuser's fault
- ✓ You won't get in trouble for telling
- ✓ Adults are here to help, not judge you
- ✓ You are incredibly brave for speaking up
- ✓ Telling someone is the right thing to do
- ✓ You deserve to be safe and happy

How to Speak Up – Step by Step

- 1** Find a trusted adult at HPA you feel comfortable with
- 2** Tell them what happened as clearly as you can
- 3** If they don't help – tell a different adult
- 4** Keep telling until you get the help you need
