Calculators in Maths / Science Lessons

Your child will require their own scientific calculator to use in all their Maths/Science lessons when they start at Hans Price Academy in September.

A scientific calculator is essential equipment for all Maths and Science lessons as well as for Independent Study and revision. It will also be required to enable students to sit assessments throughout their time at Hans Price.

As an Academy we strongly advise that all students purchase the same model of scientific calculator. This will enable us to teach students to get the most out of their calculators and learn their full functionality. If taken care of, it should last well beyond their time at Hans Price.

We recommend the Casio FX 83 GTXP which is available at a cost of £8.35. This calculator is approved by all GCSE exam boards and has the full functionality students will require to complete their studies.

If you wish to place an order for one of these calculators, please make your payment via the School's SCOPAY online payment system. The calculators will be issued to your child during the first week of term.

Food and Nutrition Ingredients
