### GCSE Paris Trip

We are delighted to announce that, as part of our Key Stage 4 French offer, we are organising a trip to Paris. The trip will run from Tuesday 7<sup>th</sup> to Friday 10<sup>th</sup> October 2025, inclusive. We will be visiting all the main tourist attraction spots in Paris, including Disneyland Paris. The trip is an ideal way for students to see the relevance of the language that they are taking to GCSE and to soak up the culture.

<b>Destination:</b>	Paris, France
<b>Dates:</b>	Tuesday 7 <sup>th</sup> October 2025 - Friday 10 <sup>th</sup> October 2025
<b>Price:</b>	£670
<b>Tour inclusions:</b>	Transport via coach/ferry. Accommodation, 3 nights at Campanile Paris Est. Visits to: Disneyland Paris Eiffel tower Bateaux Mouches Montmartre Sacre Coeur Champs Élysées Latin quarter (Possibly Notre Dame, but queues are currently a problem)
<b>Tour hoodie:</b>	Included.
<b>Recommended spending money</b>	£50 - £60 (we recommend having a Revolut or similar card, with a small amount of Euro currency in case students need to pay in cash)
<b>Supervision:</b>	Students are supervised at a ratio of 1 adult to 8 students.

**Our tour operator.** We have chosen to book our trip through **Rayburn Tours**, a specialist school tour operator since 1965, with special expertise of working with school groups. **Rayburn Tours** are fully bonded by ABTOT and ABTA protected ensuring financial security. They are also members of the School Travel Forum and hold the Learning Outside the Classroom Quality Badge.

### HPA terms and conditions:

- **Students will only be considered for the trip, if they are studying French to GCSE.**
- The trip will be operated on a first come first served basis and there are 45 places available.
- Deposits(non-refundable) of £150 to be paid by 1<sup>st</sup> March 2025.
- Students who also pose a safeguarding risk to others or themselves will be withdrawn from the trip. In the event of being withdrawn from the Paris trip for safeguarding reasons a full refund would be provided by the school.



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- A behaviour contract will be signed for the year leading up to trip. The school reserve the right to withdraw the place if a student displays behaviour which is below Ready to Learn expectations in school. Behaviour of this kind abroad could prejudice the experience for other students and staff as well as being a health and safety risk. A refund will only be offered of any money we haven't paid to Rayburn Tours.
- Students who go off roll (i.e. leave Hans Price Academy) will not be able to participate in the trip and will only be offered a refund of any money we have not yet paid to Rayburn Tours.
- Students will need their own passport.
