Dear Parents/Carers.

As you will be aware from our latest newsletter, I am delighted to have been appointed the permanent Principal of Hans Price Academy. As we reach the final days of this term, I would like to provide the following reminders for the rest of the academic year:

Uniform Expectations

Uniform is a vital part of our school's identity, it brings a sense of belonging and is an outward expression of our 'Ready To Learn' values. It reinforces who we are as a community and allows our students to feel pride in their school. We work closely with students and families to ensure that all students arrive in the correct uniform, including providing a uniform store full of freshly laundered or new items of clothing for students who need to borrow an item of uniform for the day. We also welcome uniform donations to support those who need it.

Our full Uniform policy can be found here; however, I would like to take a moment to remind you of the followina:

- Students can choose to wear a plain V-neck jumper or cardigan with no logos
- Skirts must be **tailored** and knee length
- Trousers and shorts must be tailored
- Students are required to wear school shoes and black socks (trainers are not acceptable)

Lycra/stretchy/sports shorts, skirts and leggings are **not** acceptable.

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If a student arrives at school with incorrect uniform, their College Leader or a member of the Senior Leadership Team may:

- a. Provide a change of uniform from our uniform store
- b. Send the student home to correct the uniform, having first contacted the parents/carers
- c. Send the student to R5 to work for the day.

All borrowed uniform must be returned at the end of the day. Students who do not return borrowed uniform will be charged for a replacement.

Equipment for lessons

We expect all students to bring full equipment to school. This includes

- A pencil case containing a pen, pencil, ruler, rubber and pencil sharpener. It is always advisable to carry spare pens and pencils
- A scientific calculator
- A reading book (which can be borrowed from our LRC)

Your child can buy equipment from our stationery shop in the LRC at a discounted cost. Please note that our shop is cash only.

- Pens, pencils, rubbers and sharpeners are **5p** each
- A 15cm ruler is 10p
- A clear pencil case is **50p**
