Subject(s)	Go to...	Extra information
English	Google Classroom	Complete your Tassomai Daily Goal, then complete the work on Google Classroom for dates absent.
Science	Email	Your teacher will email you to explain which task you need to complete. Make sure that you share your work with your teacher.
Maths	Dr Frost	Email your teachers for the tasks that you need to complete. Use the videos provided for extra support.
Computer Science BTEC Dance Geography Health and Social Care History Creative Media Religious Studies Travel and Tourism BTEC Sport	Google Classroom	Complete the assignment on Google Classroom which was posted on the day you were absent. Have your emails open just in case your teacher needs to give you any further information or tasks to complete.

Art	Portfolio in school	Take home your folder and spend 1 hour on your coursework for each lesson missed.

SPACE	Google Classroom	Complete the latest activity on Google Classroom. Your teacher will provide you with the join code.

Subject(s)	Go to...	Extra information
English	Google Classroom	Complete the work for the date you were absent. Email your teacher if you need a code to access Google Classroom.
Maths	SPARX	Email your teacher for the tasks to complete.
Science	Email	Your teacher will email you to explain which task you need to complete. Make sure that you share your work with your teacher.
Art, Drama & Technology	Email	Your teacher will email you instructions to explain what you need to do. Email your completed work to your teacher. Paper copies will be available from your teacher.
Computing	Google Classroom	Complete the work for the date you were absent. Have your emails open just in case your teacher needs to give you any further information or tasks to complete.
French & Spanish	Email	Complete the PowerPoint presentation by downloading it and working on it. Save it and email it back to your teacher.
Geography, History & RE	Email	Your teacher will send you an email to explain what task to complete. Paper copies are also available.
Music	Email	Start by completing the starter activity on "Teaching Gadget". Your teacher will then email you instructions to explain what you need to do. Email your completed work to your teacher.
PE	Extra Curricular	Attend one of the extra-curricular sessions offered by the PE team. This can be either a lunch or an after school club.
SPACE	Google Classroom	Complete the latest activity on Google Classroom. Your teacher will provide you with the Google Classroom code.
