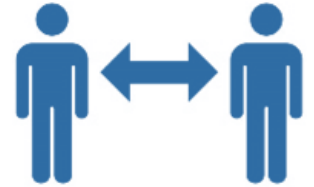


Ready To Learn

Ready To learn will still apply when we come back to school. On our first day back, the teachers will talk to the students about what it means to be *ready to learn* as we recover from the lockdown. There will be a few new routines which are necessary to keep us all safe as we move around the academy.

Social Distancing

Our students are now in year group 'bubbles'. This means they will be taught in their usual class groups, but their learning families have been reorganised in to single year groups. The teachers will remain at the front of the classroom, in a space that is 2m away from the front row of students. We must all 'keep left, keep moving, keep apart' as we move around the academy. Students will only be able to socialise with students from their year group. Clubs, sports training and seclusion are all organised in to single year groups.



Equipment and What To Bring

We are teaching the full curriculum from September, so students need to bring their usual equipment, including PE kit. Unfortunately, students cannot use their lockers at the moment.

Breaks and Lunchtimes

We have staggered breaks and lunchtimes, and zoned the school, to keep the bubbles apart at break and lunch. Each year group will have an indoor space, an outdoor space, a food server, toilet block and water bottle filler for their exclusive use. It is really important that students observe this social distancing measure. The kitchen may have a slightly reduced offer, but hot food will be available every day.



Uniform

Students should be back in full school uniform. See our website for more details. It is more important than ever that students observe the rules around minimal jewelry and short nails, to ensure that good hand hygiene is preserved.

School Attendance

Attendance is compulsory for all school-age children from September 2020. If your household were previously shielding, and you have concerns about the safety of returning to school, please contact your child's college leader in the first instance.
