Your participation in this important study has been invaluable. The results of the SIS2 study have and will be key to informing policies to help the education sector understand the impact of the pandemic and the longer-term implications of the virus on children and young people's health.

We have some important reminders:

- Please complete the online parent questionnaire and encourage your secondary school child to complete the online pupil questionnaire. We would appreciate it if you could complete the questionnaires by 1 April 2022.
- For your secondary school child to receive the £5 e-voucher for taking part in the study per round we need an email address to send the voucher to. Please contact our helpline if you have not provided an email address when enrolling your child on SIS2.
- Pupil antibody test results from second round of the study have only just arrived
 with us from the laboratory and we will be sending them directly to yourself/your
 child very soon. We anticipate being able to send the test results from the third
 round of the study to yourself/your child again around end of May.
- Keep an eye out for our upcoming publications on SIS2, available from the Office for National Statistics website. We will be publishing the wave 2 results: antibody results in early April, followed by questionnaire responses in early May. Then in June we will be publishing the wave three reports.
