Dear Parents and Carers,

### **Building Work & Use of Hans Price Academy Car Park**

In a [previous letter](#), I wrote to you about our new Resource Base due to open in September 2026. We are excited that construction has begun on this in recent weeks.

As you will appreciate, the safety of our students, families, and staff is a priority during this construction. This is particularly important during busy periods of the school day, such as students arriving and leaving school. This construction has given us the opportunity to review our approach to road safety for both our parents and students, and we appreciate your support in ensuring a safe environment for our students.

### **Motorists: Start and End of Academy Day**

Our car park has limited capacity, and congestion at busy times could create safety concerns for both pedestrians and drivers if not managed carefully and responsibly. Where possible, we kindly ask parents and carers to **consider dropping off and picking up students away from the car park** and allowing them to walk the remainder of the journey to and from the Academy.

We would also like to remind all drivers that the **designated “coach only” parking bays must not be used by cars at any time**. These spaces are essential for the safe arrival and departure of coaches and must remain clear. The diagram below may help illustrate some key points which will help to keep all our students and drivers safe.

### **Cycling to the Academy**

Students who travel by bicycle will be required to **dismount at the entrance and walk their bikes onto the Academy site**. This measure is being introduced to improve safety for all site users, especially during busy arrival and departure periods. We also strongly advise that students wear a cycle helmet. Students were informed of these expectations during their assemblies on the first week of term.

Your cooperation with these arrangements is greatly appreciated and plays an important role in keeping our Academy community safe. Thank you for your understanding and continued partnership.
