I look forward to meeting you all in person very soon.

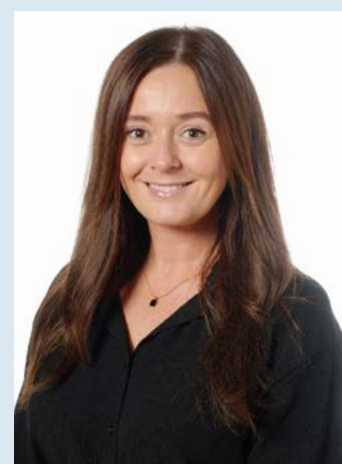

The Curriculum



At Hans Price Academy, we aim to be one of the best schools in the country, renowned for delivering outstanding academic results and developing world-class aspirations in every student, regardless of background or start-point. We have a broad range of subjects to study in KS4 to ensure students give themselves the best opportunities possible for their future.

We work on a one-week timetable, with six 50 minute periods in one day. Some lessons are singles and some doubles of 100 minutes. Here is the breakdown of the number of 50 minute periods Year 7 students have in each subject in one week.

Starting a new school can be an anxious time. If you have questions or worries, you are not alone. Here at HPA, we have a team of staff ready to support you. We will be working with you and your Primary School to help you get used to everything about HPA before you officially start in September. If you need some extra help with your learning, coping with social times or with your mental health, the Inclusion Team are here for you.

Not only do we have a variety of interventions to support students we also have a large Inclusion team. The team is led by the SENCOs and includes; Higher Level Teaching Assistants (HLTAs), Teaching Assistants (TAs), Counsellors, Mentors, a Social Emotional Mental Health Coordinator and the managers of our three bespoke provisions; Engage, Nurture and Quiet Room. We also have a provision that supports our most vulnerable students within Ready to Learn. Further to this, in September 2026 we have a new Resource Base provision opening for specific students who have been selected by the North Somerset SEND team.

March onwards – We will be happy to answer any questions that you might have, and you are also more than welcome to visit the school again or meet with any of us on request. Please email transition@hpa.clf.uk

April, May and June – We will be visiting every child and their Year 6 teacher in primary schools. We will be gaining as much information as we can from them, and you, about academic data, behaviour, likes and dislikes, friendships, extra-curricular interests and personality traits.

For any students with additional educational needs, our SEN team will meet with primary SEN partners to continue your child's support in the best possible way. There will be enhanced transition opportunities for students to visit Hans Price, with key staff from their primary school, to meet with our Academy SEN team.

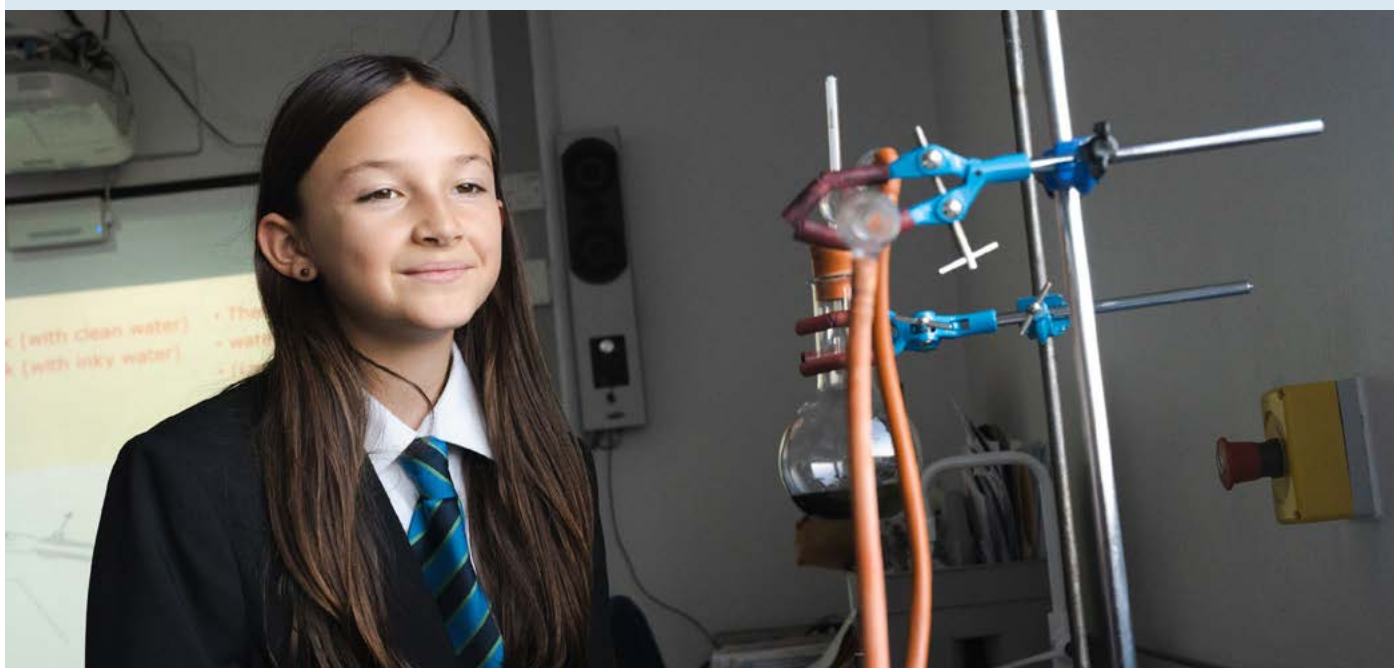
Meanwhile, we will be inviting all students to a quiz night to allow students to meet their new peers and feel more confident being in and around the Academy.
