Dear Parents/Carers,

As the last few days of Year 11 approach please take a moment to familiarise yourself with the final plans to support and celebrate our students.

Period 7 and Nightclub:

The final Period 7 will take place on Wednesday 5th June. Therefore, from Thursday 6th June students will be able to leave the academy from 3pm. We will still run Nightclub every Wednesday and Thursday from 3pm – 4.30pm after this date until Thursday 13th June for those who wish to stay in school and revise.

The alternative timetable plan for Year 11 from Tuesday 11th June:

For most of Year 11, Friday 14th June will be the last day of school. However, we recognise that by Tuesday 11th June some students will only have one exam left to go. Therefore, we have created an alternative timetable for all of Year 11 from Tuesday 11th June onwards.

We have created a **visual timetable** (attached to the letter and a paper copy sent home with students) to help you understand the times your child is expected in the academy for final lessons and exams. Please refer to this closely and contact the academy if you are unsure about when your child should attend.

Students will need to arrive **at least 15 minutes before their lessons**, Students are expected to attend the lessons for the subjects they still have exams.

Free school meals

Students in receipt of free school meals will still be able to get their food at break and/or lunch until the 30th June.

Sign off sheets

Before leaving HPA, students will need to complete a full sign off sheet. Copies of the sign-off sheet will be available through their Learning Family Tutors on the first day back after half term and can also be obtained from reception. Tutors will have the final approval for sign off.

- Return any books to their subject teacher
- Return their locker key (A £3 charge will be payable if they have lost their key)
- Return all borrowed library books (or replaced with a donation if lost)
- Pay any outstanding balance on your child's lunch account via Tucasi Scopay
