## Assessment

When looking at the new grading system bear in mind that:

- Grade 5: A "strong pass"
- Grade 4: A "standard pass"
- Grade 9: Top \% of students nationally
- Below Grade 4: still "passes", but not enough to get you onto level 3 courses (e.g. A Levels and Level 3 BTECs/T-Levels).
- Every grade counts as a GCSE.

## What subjects are compulsory?

## Key Stage 4 Curriculum

English Language + English Literature - 5 lessons a week
Mathematics - 5 lessons a week
Double Science - 5 lessons a week
Core PE - 1 double a week
Option Subjects - 1 double and 1 single lesson a week

## What choices are optional?

4 optional subjects:

- At least 1 must be an EBacc.
- At least 1 should be a BTEC.
- Plus 2 other options.
- Plus 2 reserves.
